



Socialization Of Prevention Of Sexual Harassment Through Toilet Training In The Village Of Jagoi

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ABSTRACT

Sexual harassment is still a taboo subject. This causes many victims of sexual harassment who do not dare to report to others or to the authorities. The number of cases of sexual harassment that occurred, both in the neighborhood and at school, it is important to give a good understanding of sexual harassment and how to avoid it. In response to this, the community service team needs to provide counseling about violence that occurs to children, how to communicate well with children, how to learn language in children, and the importance of conveying reproductive health to children properly. So that this socialization activity has a major role to prevent and provide knowledge and understanding of toilet training, personal areas, and sexual violence so as to prevent sexual harassment. The method used is socialization and documentation, this socialization activity was carried out on Friday, 18 January 2019 and took place in the village of Jagoi Babang. A facilitator must be very careful in the process of socialization, given the very heterogeneous conditions of the community, both the level of education, character, acceptance and understanding of the community. Socialization that is carried out to prevent sexual abuse especially in the area of private organs (sensitive areas) of the body is an important thing that should have been introduced to children from an early age. This is the duty of parents to be able to convey this information in good language and easily understood by children, because of the rampant incidence of sexual abuse, especially in children, whether boys or girls.

INTRODUCTION

One of the roles of mothers as parents who have children under five is to teach them to urinate and defecate according to their place (toilet training). Conflict that occurs at this stage is on the demands of parents who want children to control the wishes of urinate and defecate, while the child wants to issue it so feels (dying) that they want to urinate and defecate (Musfiroh dan Beny). The rise of cases of sexual harassment, especially in minors is certainly the center of attention at this time. One example of cases of children who are victims of sexual abuse by adults, even the biological parents themselves. There are even victims of child sexual abuse that cause victims to develop rectal cancer

(Fitri, 2019). KPPPA added, online information systems for women and child protection, as of January-June 2019 there were 1500 reports, specifically for reports related to child sexual violence (Eva, 2019).). Based on these data, it can be seen that there are still many cases of child sexual abuse. If the victim is a child, it must be a rather long and arduous process for psychological recovery. On the other hand, children are people who are in the process of development. Moreover, children will really remember what they saw and heard. For this reason, it is very important that parents monitor what their children see and hear to prevent sexual harassment. Whereas in most societies, sexual harassment is still taboo.

Sexual harassment is still a taboo subject causing many victims of sexual harassment who do not dare to report to others or to the authorities what happened to them. Some of them can be because the victim will feel embarrassed if what happened to him is known to others, the victim is afraid to tell others, or the victim is afraid to embarrass the family. Or worse, the victim may not know if what happened to him is sexual harassment. For this reason, so that there are no victims, it is better for the public to be given an understanding of sexual harassment and how to avoid it. METHOD

Socialization is the first step in implementing the program. Even though it looks trivial and light, the socialization process is very influential on the sustainability of the program. This socialization activity was carried out on Friday, 18 January 2019 and located in the village of Jagoi Babang a facilitator must be very careful in the process of socialization, given the condition of the community which is very heterogeneous, both levels of education, character, acceptability and community understanding. The process of socializing a facilitator at least conducts socialization related to his personal, such as name, origin, intent and purpose of coming to the area, then conducts socialization about institutions and programs, at least the facilitator informs about the profile of the institution such as the name of the institution, address of the institution, vision and mission of the institution, the work area of the institution and also the achievements of the institution. In addition to the institution's profile, the program's socialization, such as program name, program objectives, program concept, implementation period, program targets and targets, is also important. Furthermore, documentation was also carried out at the time of the socialization which was useful for archiving and evidence of community service, which the target of this socialization was all the communities around the village of Jagoi Babang, both parents, adolescents, and children.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS

Personal organs (sensitive areas) of the body are important things that should have been introduced to children from an early age. Of course this is the duty of parents to be able to convey this information in good language and easily understood by children. Why is it important? Because of the rampant incidence of sexual abuse, especially in children, whether boys or girls. One way of introduction that can be done is through toilet training. According to Kevin (2018) toilet training is a process when a child learns to urinate and defecate in the toilet like an adult. In other words, toilet training is a process when a child learns to urinate (defecate) and defecate (defecate) in the toilet so that children are taught not to urinate and defecate in their pants or diapers. Children are taught and trained to be able to tell or code when they want to urinate or defecate. Every certain time, for example 1 or 2 hours, children are invited to BAK. Or every time you wake up the child is invited to urinate and defecate. Now during this process, parents while telling the names of sensitive parts of children and teach / give understanding to children that this sensitive area should not have anyone else holding other than himself. The toilet

training stage covers the purpose of defecating, taking off clothes or pants, defecating in the toilet, cleaning parts of the body around the toilet, putting clothes back, flushing the toilet, and washing hands (Catharine, 2015).

During the toilet training process, of course patience and patience are needed from parents in dealing with children. Because it is not easy to get children used to going to the bathroom. With the understanding of sensitive areas through toilet training, it is expected to be the initial foundation until adulthood that it is very important to protect private / sensitive areas from others. The hope, sexual violence will be avoided and diminished because understanding of sexual has been understood even from an early age. According to Thoeng, sexual acts through physical or non-physical touch targeting the sexual organs or sexuality of the victim. It includes using whistles, flirting, sexual nuances, showing pornographic material and sexual desires, poking or touching parts of the body, gestures or cues that are sexual in nature so that, resulting in discomfort, offense, feeling demeaned, and may even cause health problems and safety.

The importance of the introduction of child sexual abuse so that he does not become a victim. Parents should be able to introduce to children about what sexual harassment is, what sexual harassment is like, and how to avoid it. Sexual harassment is not just like, sorry, "the union of men and women". Sexual harassment is not just that. Sexual harassment can be in the form of a body that has been touched / touched by another person. Even now minors are no exception, toddlers are also often victims. For this reason, an understanding of the private area must not be seen and held by other people is very important to be applied so as to avoid these distorted things. In addition there is also sexual harassment in the form of words, so it is very important for parents to control the vocabulary used in everyday life and teach vocabulary that is not appropriate to be used in daily conversation with children. The hope is that children will understand about sex according to their age.

Suggestion

Through the socialization that has been carried out by STKIP Singkawang lecturers with students, so that this can be used as a warning for us together to protect and introduce children and adolescents to dare to take a stand and refuse if there are mistakes that are not by their beliefs. Furthermore, hopefully through this activity the government, related parties, parents and the surrounding community will be more sensitive. Furthermore, it can make sexual education as the main education which will be useful for children/adolescents in the future.

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
